ORIENTING DATA FOR PHILIPPIANS

Content: Paul's thanksgiving for, encouragement of, and exhortation to the suffering community of believers in Philippi, who are also experiencing some internal struggles

Date: Around 62 A.D., almost certainly from Rome

Author: Paul, and his younger companion Timothy

Recipients: The church in Philippi (mostly Gentile), originally founded by Paul, Silas, and Timothy

Emphases: Paul's and the Philippians' partnership in the gospel; Christ as the key to all of life... rejoicing in Christ even in suffering, unity through humility and love; the certainty and pursuit of the final prize
