"Save me, Lord!" he shouted. 31 Jesus immediately reached out and grabbed him. "You have so little faith," Jesus said. "Why did you doubt me?"

Don't ignore doubt—**explore** it. Jesus welcomes honest scrutiny because truth has nothing to hide. As we examine our doubts, we find answers. And Jesus doesn't wait for us to have it all figured out—when we call on Him, He responds immediately. In the end, exploring doubt leads to even more reasons to believe.
